

# Brownie Pinwheel

*Materials: sheet, scissors, 1 straight pin, 2 beads, pencil with eraser, masking tape.*

Cut along the solid lines of the square.

Cut along the lines going into the square.

Slide a bead onto a straight pin.

Put a small piece of masking tape over center dot.

Fold the four blades by pulling the corners without type toward the center.

Press corners to make sure the tape holds. Do not crease the folds.

Pass the pin through the center of the pinwheel to hold the blades together.

Slide another bead onto the pin behind the paper.

Stick the pin into the side of the eraser on an unused pencil.
